- (a) Here insert R.A.F., R.A.F.V.R., A.A.F., W.A.A.F. or Class E or F Reserve, as applicable.
- (b) Applicable only to a Class E or F Reservist or an airman of the Auxiliary Air Force.
- (c) Delete " Discharge " or " Transfer to Class.....Reserve, " as applicable. In respect of airmen " Cause of Discharge or Transfer to Reserve. " should give precise words as applicable in K.R. & A.C.I., paras. 652 or 651.
- (d) " V.G. " is the highest character which can be awarded in the Royal Air Force.
